SCOPE OF WORK:

Overall project scope included excavation of new asphalt pedestrian trail, providing new stone base, new pavement, installing 2 pedestrian bridges and signs. CW Purpero was an awarded General Contractor.

Hoffman Landscape scope was the erosion control services which included over 1,000 LF of silt fence installation and removal. Other part was finish grading and hydroseeding along the shoulders of pedestrian trail. We've successfully seeded over 35,000 SY of turf areas in Hanson Park and along the trails.

Retaining wall installation presented some challenges due to the metal railing to be installed on top of the wall and therefore necessary base preparations.

Some challenges were also presented to us by our fist time trail and pedestrian sign installations. We've installed overall 170 signs on roads and trail system.
